9.1.1 QUARTER PALLET

Maximum Footprint 1.2m x 1.2m
 Maximum Height 0.6m (including pallet)
 Maximum Weight 250 Kilos (including pallet)

9.1.2 HALF PALLET

Maximum Footprint 1.2m x 1.2m
 Maximum Height 1.0m (including pallet)
 Maximum Weight 500 Kilos (including pallet)

9.1.3 FULL PALLET

Maximum Footprint 1.2m x 1.2m
 Maximum Height 2.2m (including pallet)
 Maximum Weight 1250 Kilos (including pallet)

9.1.4 HALF OVERSIZE PALLET

Maximum Footprint 1.2m x 2.4m
 Maximum Height 1.0m (including pallet)
 Maximum Weight 500 Kilos (including pallet)

9.1.5 FULL OVERSIZE PALLET

Maximum Footprint 1.2m x 2.4m
 Maximum Height 2.2m (including pallet)
 Maximum Weight 1500 Kilos (including pallet)

9.1.6 The above dimensions are for guidance purposes. It is recognised and accepted that a level of tolerance up to 20cm, length or width, **but not both**, should be permitted on all pallets above. However, it is the Input Depots responsibility to ensure they manifest the pallets accurately.

9.1.7 Any pallet measuring greater than the pallet definitions will be deemed Out of Gauge (OOG).

9.1.8 OOG carries **NO SERVICE LEVEL** through the Network and should not be encouraged.

9.1.9 OOG freight will not take preference over any other freight that has been manifested, unless the Delivery Depot has agreed in writing to ensure sufficient additional resource will be available to clear the freight from the Hub and deliver to agreed service.

9.2.0 Whilst every effort will be made to move/deliver OOG freight as quickly as possible, neither the Delivery Depot, nor the Hub will be held responsible for OOG freight being decked or delivered.

9.2.1 If the Requesting Depot requires OOG freight moving and the Delivery Depot cannot offer this, then all costs will be forwarded to the Requesting Depot.

9.2.2 If mutually agreed, then additional revenue requests for delivering OOG freight should be made via a Form B, with an authorising signature from the Requesting Depot.
